Our guest speaker will be from Summit County Search & Rescue. Newcomers' are known to pursue numerous risky and extreme sports. Recent memory does not recall instances of Newcomers' needing rescuing, but that could change. Luckily, Summit County is home to an award-winning Search and Rescue Department, so help is at hand.

Sgt. Siddoway from the Summit County Sheriff's Department will be on hand to tell us what the Search and Rescue Department does and what training is necessary. He may relate some of the rescues the group has performed and will tell us how to play safely in the wilderness. Locating missing hikers, skiers, snowshoers and snowmobile riders are common assignments for the team. Search & Rescue has conducted more than 35% of the searches statewide over the past ten years. So, either Park City residents are more active than others in Utah, or visitors are not well prepared for the wilderness.

## BRIDGE CLUB



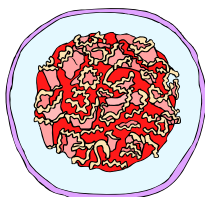

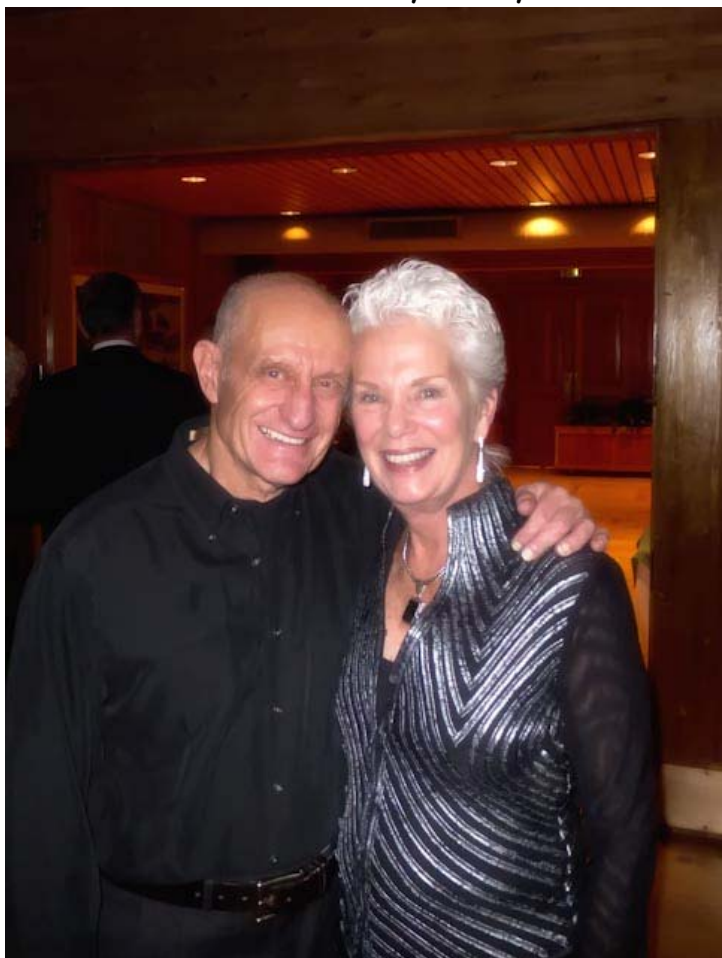

We are pleased to announce that we will be doing the following events with the Park City Mountain Sports Club!

### Monday, Feb 6 - Hardware Ranch

This trip will include a bus trip from Smith's to Hardware Ranch (1 ½ to 2 hrs. each way) where the bus will drop us off at the Visitor Center. Then, we will board horse-drawn sleighs to ride through the elk herd. We will have someone giving information about the elks and the ranch. We will leave Smith's at 11:15 am and spend about two hours at the ranch before returning.

### Saturday, Mar 24 - Antelope Island

This trip will include a bus trip from Smith's to Antelope Island (about 1 ½ hrs. each way) taking us first to the Visitor Center. Then, we will travel to the other end of the island to Fielding Garr Ranch. We hope to see antelope, a free-roaming herd of 500 bison, mule deer, pronghorn antelope and big horn sheep that all share the rangelands. We will leave Smith's at 12:00pm and spend about two hours on Antelope Island before returning.
