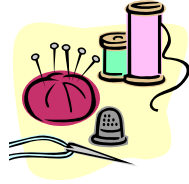

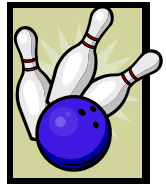

We are pleased to announce that we will be doing the following events with the Park City Mountain Sports Club!

Monday, Feb 6 - Hardware Ranch


This trip will include a bus trip from Smith's to Hardware Ranch (1 ½ to 2 hrs. each way) where the bus will drop us off at the Visitor Center. Then, we will board horse-drawn sleighs to ride through the elk herd. We will have someone giving information about the elks and the ranch. We will leave Smith's at 11:15am and spend about two hours at the ranch before returning.

Saturday, Mar 24 - Antelope

This trip will include a bus trip from Smith's to Antelope Island (about 1 ½ hrs. each way) taking us first to the Visitor Center. Then, we will travel to the other end of the island to Fielding Garr Ranch. We hope to see antelope, a free-roaming herd of 500 bison, mule deer, pronghorn antelope and big horn sheep that all share the rangelands. We will leave Smith's at 12:00pm and spend about two hours on Antelope Island before returning.
